#### **JANUARY**

The Neighborhood SUCCESS Grants Program awards grants totaling \$105,736 to 27 residentled Warren and Youngstown grassroots groups transforming their neighborhoods.

#### **FEBRUARY**

Year-long Race, Equity and Inclusion **Training** commences in the Valley to deepen understanding of systemic racism, challenge deeply-held assumptions and reveal the devastating impacts of persistent racial inequality.

#### **MARCH**

**Community Investment Grants** are awarded to ESOP, International Partners in Mission, Invent Now, We Are Warren and Youngstown CityScape for their work in community revitalization, educational opportunity and economic opportunity.

Funded by a CommunityWINS grant, Strategic Partner, Youngstown Neighborhood **Development Corporation**, transforms a vacant commercial property, into The Glenwood Business Center, a turn-key space for neighborhood-serving businesses.

#### **NOVEMBER**

Designed to cultivate resident leadership and foster radical imagination, the **Emerging Leaders Program** 2018 cohort joins its robust alumni association in creating a healthy, vibrant, equitable and economically stable Mahoning Valley.

#### **DECEMBER**

Community Investment Grants are awarded to City Club of the Mahoning Valley and YSU's Center for Nonprofit Leadership for their work in public sector leadership development and increasing civic engagement.
